

Meal Applications FAQs

Q: What can I do to ensure prompt application approval?

A: To ensure prompt application approve please:

- Use black or blue ink
- Print Clearly
- Use your students name and date of birth as it appears on their Birth Certificate
- List all household members
- Fill out the last 4 digits of your social security number or check the box with no social security number
- Sign the application

Q: Do I need to fill out an application for each child?

A: No. Complete one application for all students in the household.

Q: What if my income is not always the same?

A: Please contact the Nutritional Services Department at (913) 627-3900 for further instructions.

Q: Will the information I give me checked?

A: Yes, we may ask you to send written proof of the information you give.

Q: Have eligibility guidelines changed from last year?

A: Yes. The eligibility guidelines have changed from last year and you do need to fill out a new application each year.

Q: Can homeless, runaway and migrant students get free meals?

A: Yes, if you are a homeless, runaway or migrant student, please contact Kerry Wrenick or Alejandro Cabero at (913) 551-3200.

Q: I got a letter that says my student's school has free breakfast and lunch. Do I need to fill out an application?

A: KCKPS is excited that all Early Childhood, Elementary and Middle Schools receive free meals. However, for this program, and many other federal and local programs, to continue, students must have applications on file each year.
